

Message from Renaud Civil

August 2013 during his first visit to the US.....

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Since English is my third language, I felt the need to write my thoughts down in order to say what I mean.

HAC began in Haiti in 1998. I just want you to know that we are not an occasional organization that the earthquake gave birth to. Many organizations came down, and after a few months, they left.

Because of the quality of our service at our clinics, the number of people, especially after the earthquake, continues to increase day after day. For this reason, we are planning to build a hospital in order to meet more needs of the people, and be a bigger blessing to them.

We treat 1,500 to 2,000 patients a month at all the Hope Alive Clinics. Many people come from far away, 10 to 15 miles, to have our service. Guess why? All our medications are excellent and

FREE to all our patients. (A fee of \$1.25 helps pay doctor salaries.) Some patients get many prescriptions each time they come.

We have a nutritional program at two clinics where we train and educate mothers medically, so they know what to do in case their child has a problem at night and can't go to a medical center. We provide formula, food, and medical care for them every month completely free of charge. Mom-Tots are chosen based on the criteria of Malnutrition.

We are looking for funds to continue to run the clinics and to build the hospital. We need mom-tot sponsors (\$25/month), medical supplies like a portable x-ray machine, portable sonogram machine, portable EKG machine, specific medicines, an ambulance, food.

If you are a nurse, a medical doctor, a dentist, a medical or dental professional, please come and bless our patients.

If you are another professional: Plumber, Painter, Mechanic, Welder, etc. we have jobs for you.

If you are a teacher, pastor, or if you have a willing heart to help, you will find something to do to feel good about yourself. We need people to preach the Gospel and pray with patients too.

We have a guest house that can hold about 20 people. You will be very welcome in Haiti and at HACM!

We need your help more than ever because of the rapid increasing of our activities and rising cost of life.

Sometimes, to know how you are blessed, you need to visit another country. I am convinced that a trip to Haiti will make a big difference in your life.

Thank you to those of you who have helped us...

For many years we have been blessed by you (pursue of Jesus), and we come to understand that it is important for you to hear from the recipients some words of gratitude showing how they appreciate your help and love you.

You are motivated by love to help the people of Haiti. Because you have life and joy, you want to extend it to many people through the Gospel that is preached, and medicines, food, clothes, and shoes. Thank you for collecting things for Haiti.

Many people respond to the call of Jesus because of your generous gift and the expression of Jesus' love through your

action. Action, sometimes, speaks louder than words. Through your action, they are living like human beings now, in a clean and safe environment.

Thanks to God, you are like His hands to reach the poorest class of the Haitian society who can't afford to pay for their medical service.

Our clients are especially children and women. Through our Mom-Tot Program, many mothers are educated; they know now what to do if they (or their relatives) have a fever at night, vomiting, etc. In the Mom-Tot Program, we also give them food, formula, and medicine for free.

On behalf of the Haitian people and on my personal name, I bow down before your loving heart and your willingness to continue to fund this ministry to say: Thank you so much. May God bless you abundantly!
